Overview

Responsibilities

Duties include but not limited to operating vehicle in a safe and efficient manner; daily checks of vehicle for safe operation and vehicle maintenance such as filling gas tanks and cleaning exterior and interior; timeliness and follow assigned route; and accountable for safety while operating vehicle. Responsible for taking all necessary and reasonable precautions to protect members; report incidents and completing documentation; maintain discipline; and be a positive role model.

There is potential for exposure to germs and illnesses. Employees are to follow all safety procedures and protocols. The noise level in the work environment is usually loud and at times moderate or very loud. Position requires transporting large groups of youth.
