Restroom/Locker Room Policy

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Central Georgia (BGCCG) is committed to providing a safe environment and enforces the following Restrooms/Locker Rooms policy for club members, staff, volunteers, and approved guest.

At Boys & Girls Clubs of Central Georgia's club facilities, the restrooms / locker rooms are designated as male and female, unisex, or other arrangement. These facilities are to be used by club members, staff, volunteers, and other BGCCG approved guest.

- Restrooms/Locker rooms shall be regularly inspected and monitored by a designated same gender staff and/or volunteer at a schedule set by Club leadership.
- Staff must adhere to the established supervision ratios of 15:1 at all times.
- Before youth members enter the restrooms/locker rooms, staff should complete a sweep of the facility to ensure no unauthorized adults or youth are inside.
- Staff should position themselves outside the restrooms/locker rooms changing area near the door in-order to be visible and within listening range without infringing on member's privacy.
- Exterior restrooms/locker rooms doors should remain open when in use by youth, as long as this does not violate the privacy of those inside.
- No audio or video recording devices are allowed in the locker room, including cellphones.
- Boys & Girls Clubs of Central Georgia do not provide restrooms/locker rooms for public use.
